"No Other Name" March 5, 2017.

There is so much tied up in your name: your identity, your credibility, your authority, your heritage and your legacy. There is power in a name. And, if you are authorized to act in someone else's name, there may be even more weight behind it. But there are limits to my name or your name or anyone's name can achieve.

But Jesus' name is different. There are no limits. This Sunday we will explore what this means for us if we belong to Him.


