

Hurricane Harvey Relief Update

Time goes on and life gets back to normal, but for the people impacted by hurricane Harvey normal is not a word that will describe their lives for a long time. We can help make a difference in the lives of people in the gulf coast, you can make a difference. Through your generosity, \$7,403 was given last Sunday for disaster relief efforts in Houston and the surrounding area. If you didn't have a chance to give last week it is not too late. We will forward all funds raised this week to the appropriate agencies in the area. The church has received several requests for help and we will try to accommodate these requests as best we can. As we have done before, and as previously announced, we will work primarily through the Church of Christ Disaster Response Team out of Nashville. Singing Oaks has worked with this organization before, after the tornado in Alabama and the fire that devastated Bastrop several years ago. Bible Study Fellowship

Bible Study Fellowship (BSF) is an inter-denominational Bible study divided into groups of men and women that meet each week for in depth Bible study with the hope of producing in each participant a passionate commitment to Christ, His word and His church. This year's study is the book of Romans. The evening BSF ladies group meets here at the church building and numbers approximately 300 ladies. The men's group meets at Southmont Baptist and has about 250 in attendance. The daytime ladies group numbers 625 and meets at First Baptist Denton at 9:30 on Wednesday morning. Both the men's and ladies evening groups meet on Monday night at 6:55. All BSF groups offer classes for children with lessons and applications from the book of Romans. Monday night classes start tomorrow night September 11 and will run through the first week in May with time off for Christmas and Spring Break. The daytime ladies class starts on Wednesday, September 13. Try it, you will love it.
