Singing Oaks is required to safe place train all teachers and helpers in our youth and children's ministries. Our insurance requires this training, but it is also a beneficial learning tool for all of us who work with the children in our church family, whether through Leadership Training for Christ, Camp Victory in the summer, or Attended Nursery during Sunday Worship Services or teaching a Bible Class. God simply asks us to be obedient, and sometimes obedience looks like a background check and 45 minutes of prevention training. And, as a Safe Place Trained Volunteer you are also required to wear a photo ID badge while teaching or working with children and youth. Elder Affirmation


