

Land Update
ECM Development is proceeding with the plans to develop the north 34.9 acres of land we are in contract for. The plan is exciting and includes approximately 151 single family homes and 74 townhomes and duplexes all on tree lined streets connected by walking trails and parks. The single family home development will be called Eden Villas. Working through the approval process with the City of Denton is not easy, but it is progressing. ECM has been meeting and working with the City of Denton's Planning & Zoning Department, City Council members and other departments to obtain approval of their design concept. ECM is optimistic with plans to close in early 2020.


