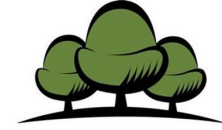

## Grow Group Questions for February 2<sup>nd</sup> 2020.

### Sermon: "The Manifold Wisdom of God."

In the Lord's prayer we pray, "Thy will be done." But, how can creatures like us come to know the very will of God. Do we know it? Can we think like He thinks? The greatest thing that anyone can ever seek is to know the wisdom of God. The only way you can know it is to experience it in your own life.

- Ask everyone to share any God stories since last you met.
- Begin with a prayer of thanks... perhaps a chain prayer of thanks.

#### Questions.

1. What in this sermon stood out to you?
  - What personally convicted you in this sermon? Which scriptures?
  - Is there anything you are going to try to change?
2. When have you experienced God's "manifold wisdom?"
  - Do you often stop to discern what God is doing? "Do you ask for His wisdom?"
  - Who do you know who seems to have the "mind of Christ?"
  - Do you often ask, "What would Jesus do in this situation?"
3. What is the wisdom that you lack right now? (James 1:5).
  - What do you think God is teaching you right now?
  - What has he taught you in the past?
  - Do you think there is a big lesson He wants you personally to learn in life?

Perhaps you could end your time together with a period of silence before God. Then transition into a season of prayer for wisdom... whatever wisdom each of you lacks.
