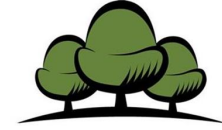

## Grow Group Questions for March 1<sup>st</sup> 2020.

### Sermon: "The Spirit And The Word."

Begin with a time of silence before God, inviting God's Holy Spirit into this time and space. Then invite everyone into an open free flowing prayer time. Then:

- Ask everyone to share their God stories since last you met.
- What thought or what scripture from this sermon hit you?

#### Questions.

1. I said, "Everyone is living out a story whether you know it or not. If you don't know your story then you aren't living it. It is living you."
  - What adventures and trials have you experienced in your life?
  - How did those experiences change you?
  - Do you see the hand of God in or through them? How?
2. I said, "There are encounters with God that you can only have through scripture."
  - a. Have you ever had a scripture just grab you?... How? And what were the circumstances?
  - b. What scriptures have become deeply personal to you? What are the verses that you fall back on again and again and again?
3. I said, "God wants to enlarge your heart. Scripture invites us to experience a larger reality."
  - When have you experienced that?
  - What battles have you fought that led to that kind of breakthrough?

Close with a chain prayer about your current battles. Or pray Eph 3:14-21.

(Don't shut down any spontaneity if it breaks out during your time together). Lol.
